## *Scandinavian Journal of Immunology* is recruiting a new Editor-in-Chief

The Scandinavian Foundation for Immunology is seeking a new Editor-in-Chief for the *Scandinavian Journal of Immunology*. The Editor-in-Chief will be officially and fully operative responsible for the Journal and its management from 2018 and at least five years ahead.

The journal is the official publication of the Scandinavian Society for Immunology (SSI).

Duties of the Editor-in-Chief includes:

- The Editor-in-Chief takes responsibility of the scientific contents of the *Scandinavian Journal of Immunology* in cooperation with members of the Editorial Board.
- The Editor-in-Chief should make every effort to actively solicit and publish authoritative, original and high-quality research articles in the field of experimental and human immunology.
- The Editor-in-Chief will supervise the processes of peer review, reviewer selection, and communication with authors. He/she will make every effort to ensure a rapid and efficient review of all submitted papers.
- The Editor-in-Chief has full authority to appoint members of the Editorial Board, whom will assist the Editor-in-Chief in the peer review process and other matters related to the journal.
- The Editor-in-Chief will supervise the processes of peer

review, reviewer selection, and communication with authors. He/she will make every effort to ensure a rapid and efficient review of all submitted papers.

- The Editor-in-Chief will maintain the flow of accepted papers at a level and on a schedule for regular monthly publication of the *Scandinavian Journal of Immunology*
- The general structure (Editor(s)-in-Chief, Associate Editor(s), Editorial Board Members) is to be agreed upon between the Editor-in-Chief and the Scandinavian Foundation for Immunology.
- The Editor-in-Chief will identify, select and monitor key performance indicators (KPI) by which to assess performance of the Journal and its editorial team.

#### Application package:

- A current curriculum vitae from which it shall be made clear the candidates' skills and position in the field including:
  - An internationally recognized standing in the field of immunology
  - A broad overview and knowledge with the field of immunology
  - Experience from in editorial decision-making
  - Excellent skills in editing and writing
- Evaluation of the *Scandinavian Journal of Immunology's* current content, organization, appearance and policies along with recommendations for change, if any.
- Specific objectives he/she wants to achieve over the duration of his/her term.
- Strategies to increase readership, reputation and impact factor.

- Approach to maintaining the quality, accuracy and fairness of the review process.
