

Unique opportunity for establishment as a senior researcher/postdoc in the field of autoimmunity

At the Department of Inflammation Research (IIR), which is affiliated with the Center for Rheumatology and Spine Diseases, Copenhagen University Hospital Rigshospitalet, a position as senior researcher/research assistant (37 hours per week) is available for immediate appointment. You will have a unique opportunity to establish your own research group in a clinic-based research environment.

The employment period is 24 months with the possibility of extension.

The workplace is IIR's laboratory facilities at Copenhagen University Hospital Rigshospitalet, section 7541.

Applicants with research interests that complement the on-going research within the department will be preferred.

About the Institute for Inflammation Research:

IIR conducts research into pathogenetic mechanisms behind inflammation, including autoimmune diseases and immunomodulatory drugs. In agreement with the head of the laboratory, the applicant will have the opportunity to establish as an independent researcher in a well-equipped laboratory in close collaboration with clinicians, including rheumatologists, neurologists, endocrinologists, haematologists, cardiologists, paediatricians and ophthalmologists at Copenhagen University Hospital, as well as with dentists and immunologists at the nearby University of Copenhagen. The applicant is expected to participate in the supervision of PhD and Master's degree students, instruction of lab technicians for daily tasks, and the preparation of grant applications.

- Holds an MD, PhD, or equivalent in biological sciences.
- Has demonstrated significant research output through publications.
- Experience with supervision and work management will be preferred.
- Documented ability to attract funds will be preferred.
- Possesses good collaboration skills.
